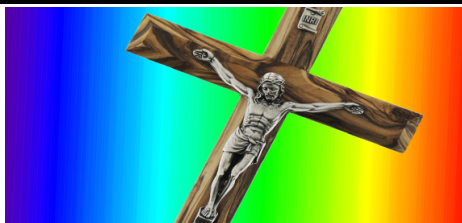


Is social welfare biblical? Join us to watch this award-winning film, have something to eat and discuss what practical compassion means in our world.
